Sisters of Watts has expanded its programs and offerings to the community by hosting free backpack giveaways, youth clean-up days in the community, turkey giveaways, toy giveaways, a peace march for youth, CPR classes, free family fun nights, a special needs shoe giveaway, free bike safety classes, free haircuts for the youth and the homeless, and our Homeless Shower of Love. We stationed our mobile home in Watts and provided a hot shower, personal hygiene packs, clean clothes, and a hot meal. We also responded to the needs of those who are greatly impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic. We have implemented a free grab and go food program and a meal delivery program for seniors, the disabled, and the homeless.
